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## I. General Information

Below we inform you about the processing of personal data when using this website (jermaik.com) and the contact and booking forms offered on it.

Personal data is any data that can be related to you personally, such as name, address, email, phone number, IP address, or user behavior.

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## II. Who is the controller?

The controller responsible for data processing within the meaning of the GDPR is:

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## III. Data Protection Officer

We are not legally required to appoint a data protection officer. For any questions regarding the processing of your data, you are welcome to contact us at any time (contact details above).

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## **IV. Who is affected by this data processing?**

This applies to all visitors of this website, as well as anyone who contacts us via the contact or booking forms (hereinafter "users").

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## **V. What data do we collect and for what purpose?**

### ***1. When simply visiting the website***

When you access this website, our hosting provider (see VI.) automatically processes technically necessary data, in particular:

- IP address of the requesting device
- Date and time of the request
- Name and URL of the file retrieved
- Access status / HTTP status code
- Amount of data transferred
- Website from which the request originates (referrer URL)
- Browser and operating system used

This processing is necessary to display the website and ensure its stability and security (legal basis: Art. 6(1)(f) GDPR).

### ***2. When using the contact (inquiry) form***

If you contact us via the inquiry form, we process the data you voluntarily enter, in particular: name, email address, details about your planned wedding (date, location, desired services, budget, message).

### ***3. When using the booking form***

Once you have accepted our offer, the booking form processes significantly more data for the binding execution of the contract, in particular: both partners' names, address (which also serves as the billing address), email address, phone number, wedding date and venue, booked services, agreed price, details on travel and, if applicable, accommodation, as well as the consents you give (including for self-promotion use) together with the timestamp of your consent.

This processing takes place to carry out pre-contractual measures and to fulfil the contract concluded with you (legal basis: Art. 6(1)(b) GDPR).

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## **VI. Who do we share your data with? (service providers used)**

We use carefully selected external service providers who process data on our behalf or on the basis of a legitimate interest:

**Hosting:** This website is hosted by Strato AG, Otto-Ostrowski-Straße 7, 10249 Berlin, Germany. Your IP address is processed when you visit the site. For details, see Strato's privacy policy at [strato.de](https://www.strato.de).

**Form delivery:** Inquiries submitted via our contact and booking forms are technically transmitted and delivered to us by email via the service Formspree (Formspree, Inc., Austin, Texas, USA). Formspree processes the data you enter in the respective form as well as technical data (including your IP address). This constitutes a transfer of data to the USA. Formspree has committed to complying with the GDPR and relies on EU Standard Contractual Clauses for the transfer. **Embedded videos:** In certain places, this website embeds videos via Wistia (Wistia, Inc., 17 Tudor St, Boston, MA 02116, USA). When you play a video, Wistia may process data including your IP address. This constitutes a transfer of data to the USA. The background video in the header of the wedding pages, by contrast, is delivered directly from our own server and does not involve any third party.

**Fonts (Google Fonts):** For consistent typography, we use Google Fonts (Google LLC, 1600 Amphitheatre Parkway, Mountain View, CA 94043, USA). These are only loaded after your explicit consent via our cookie banner; without consent, the website uses system default fonts. When consent is given, loading the fonts constitutes a transfer of data to the USA (your IP address is transmitted to Google). For details, see Google's privacy policy at [policies.google.com/privacy](https://policies.google.com/privacy).

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## VII. Is your data transferred outside the EU?

Yes, in connection with the services listed under VI. (Formspree, Wistia, and where applicable Google Fonts), data is transferred to the USA. These providers have contractually committed to maintaining a level of data protection equivalent to the GDPR, in particular via EU Standard Contractual Clauses (Art. 46 GDPR).

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## VIII. How long do we process your data?

Inquiry data is deleted once it is no longer needed to process your request, at the latest 12 months after an inquiry that does not result in a booking. Booking and contract data is subject to statutory retention periods (in particular 6–10 years under German commercial and tax law, §§ 257 HGB, 147 AO). Server log files are deleted automatically after a short period, unless longer retention is required for security purposes (e.g. to investigate attacks).

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## IX. What are your rights?

You have the following rights regarding your personal data:

- **Access** to the data we process about you (Art. 15 GDPR)
- **Rectification** of inaccurate data (Art. 16 GDPR)
- **Erasement** of your data, unless a statutory retention obligation applies (Art. 17 GDPR)
- **Restriction of processing** (Art. 18 GDPR)
- **Data portability** (Art. 20 GDPR)

- **Objection** to processing (Art. 21 GDPR)
- **Withdrawal** of any consent given, with future effect (Art. 7(3) GDPR)
- **Lodging a complaint** with a supervisory authority (Art. 77 GDPR)

To exercise these rights, an informal message to us is sufficient (contact details above).

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## **X. Right to Object (Art. 21 GDPR)**

Where your data is processed on the basis of legitimate interests (Art. 6(1)(f) GDPR), you have the right to object at any time, for reasons arising from your particular situation, to the processing. An informal message to us is sufficient (contact details above).

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## **XI. Withdrawing Consent**

Any consent given (e.g. for the use of Google Fonts, or for self-promotion use) may be withdrawn at any time with future effect. An informal message to us is sufficient (contact details above).

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## **XII. Where can you file a complaint?**

You have the right to lodge a complaint with a data protection supervisory authority. The competent authority is the Landesbeauftragte für den Datenschutz und die Informationsfreiheit Rheinland-Pfalz.

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## **XIII. Is providing your data required?**

Providing your data in the contact and booking forms is voluntary but necessary to process your inquiry or to carry out the booking contract. Without this information, we cannot process your inquiry or perform the contract.

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## **XIV. Automated Decision-Making**

No automated decision-making, including profiling, takes place.

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## **XV. How do we secure our website?**

This website uses SSL/TLS encryption to protect data transmission, recognizable by "https" in the address bar.

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## **XVI. Cookies**

This website uses only technically necessary cookies, as well as — following your explicit consent via the cookie banner — Google Fonts (see VI.). No cookies are used for advertising or tracking purposes. The legal basis for technically necessary cookies is Art. 6(1)(f) GDPR; for consent-based content it is Art. 6(1)(a) GDPR.
